Summer Opportunities for Advancement & Recovery

Dates: June 1st-July 2nd (Monday-Thursday)

Time: 7:30 am-11:00 am

(students may work at any time of the day that works for them, but teachers will be available from 7:30-11:00 am)

WHS will hold a virtual summer school this year! The online platform we will use is the same as last year. We will be abiding by the CDC guidelines for social distancing due to COVID-19. Certified teachers will be assigned to students to assist through coursework and troubleshoot technology questions. Once Summer School begins, students will be able to sign up for tutoring where they physically come into the West Wing and meet with their teacher for assistance, again, following CDC guidelines. Tutoring will be in 30 minute increments and only 4-6 students will be allowed in a classroom at a time. Other than coming in for tutoring, students will NOT be allowed on campus for 2020 Summer School. On or before the first day of Summer School, students will receive an email from their teacher as well as from the online platform on how to log in and begin their course work. Communication with students will occur via email and phone if parental permission is granted below.

Enrollment for SDOW students will be from May 11th-21st.

On May 18th, depending on available spots, enrollment may open up to students outside of the SDOW.

Students may take classes for credit recovery or credit advancement.

A maximum of 2 courses can be taken, each worth 0.5 credit.
