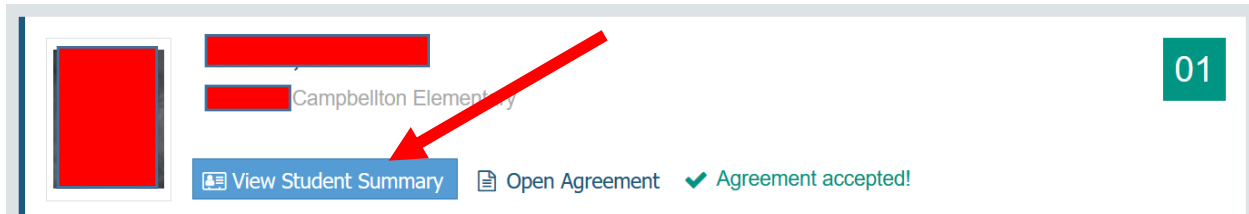


## Parent Portal Viewing Standards-Based Data Points and Grades

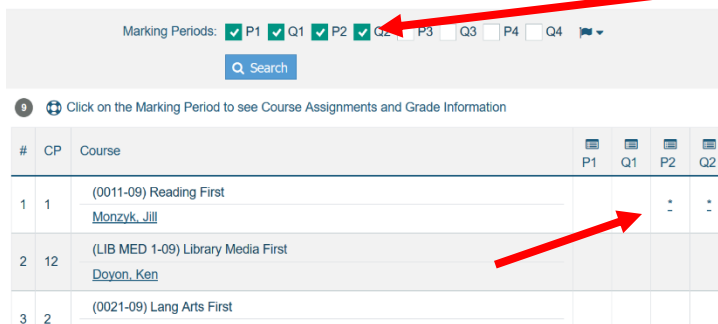
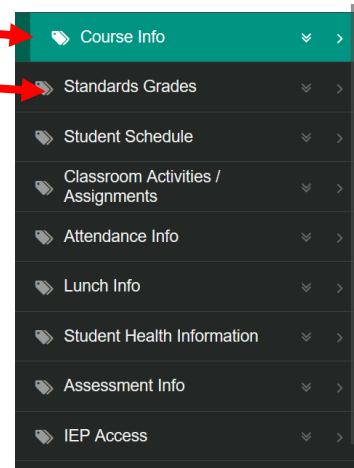
Log into Lumen using your unique ID and Password. Next to the student you wish to view, click **View Student Summary**.



Once you are in the portal, you can choose between **Course Info** (for the entry of each data point) or **Standards Grades**.

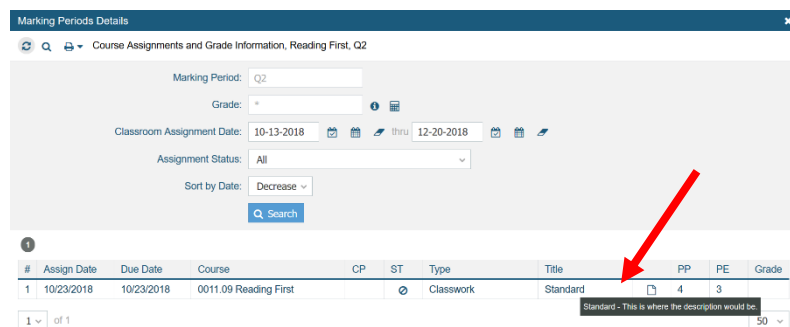
When you choose **Course Info**, this allows you to see each of the individual assignments/assessments given to your student to determine mastery of a particular standard. (There will not be a letter grade or a percent for any of these as they are graded based on a rubric of not more than 4 points.) Rubrics can be found on the district web site at the following link:

To see all of the data points for a particular course, click the arrow to the right of **Course Info**. This opens a window on the right that shows all courses. Search for the correct marking period (Q1, Q2, etc.) and click on the \* in that column.

Each assignment for that course will appear. You will need to “hover” over the description to see the actual assignment description.



Once you have viewed all of the assignments/assessments, you can go to the **Standards Grades** area to view the final score (at the end of the quarter only) for each standard assessed during a particular marking period. Be sure to choose the correct marking period, click Search, and scroll to find the course you wish to view.
