SUPERVISION OF STUDENTS

Descriptor Code: JHFA

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The Board expects all students to be under assigned adult **supervision** at all times when in school, on school grounds, traveling under school auspices or engaging in school-sponsored activities. **Supervision** must not be limited to the classroom, but must extend to the halls and corridors, playgrounds, lunch rooms, extracurricular activities, or any place where students gather on school property during the regular instructional or extracurricular activities program. Teachers are encouraged to report violations of policies, rules and regulations by students during the school day, or while attending school-sponsored activities. Teachers must not ignore the need under the pretext of not having been assigned a particular **supervision**.

School personnel assigned specific supervisory duties are expected to act as reasonably prudent adults in providing for the safety and welfare of the students in their charge. In keeping with this expected prudence, no teacher or other staff member will leave an assigned group unsupervised except to make arrangements to take care of an emergency.
